TASK: As part of your application you need to put together a formal business proposal (five or more pages) that will be judged by people outside the school who are experienced in investing in business ventures. The proposal needs to include the following elements with as much detail as possible.

- → Name of business
- → Name of people who own the business
- → Address of business
- → The business idea
 - How you came up with the idea
 - How is it different to similar businesses
- → How much money you need to be invested in the business
- → A paragraph outlining why the potential investor should invest in YOUR business
